Get the pulse of the city with our welcome tour giving you the basics of Bucharest and local tips.

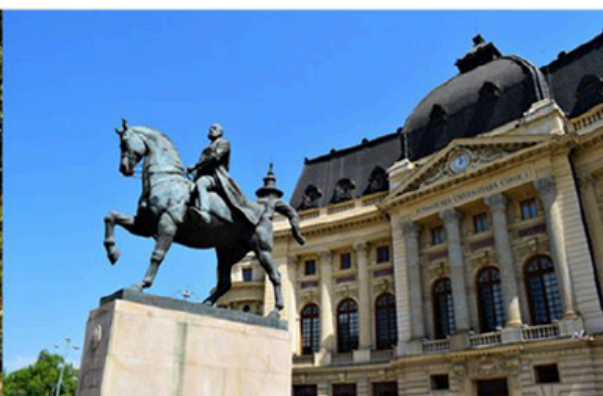
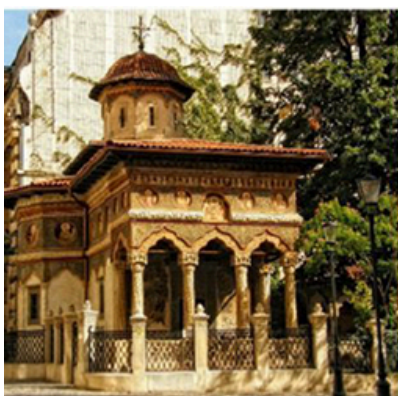
Stroll through more than 500 years of history from the times of Vlad the Impaler aka Dracula to the "golden era" of communism, the '89 Revolution.

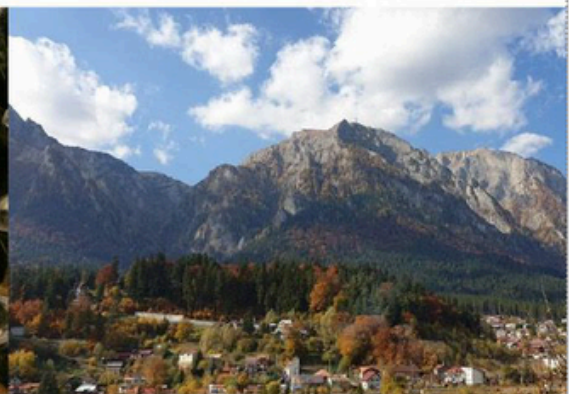
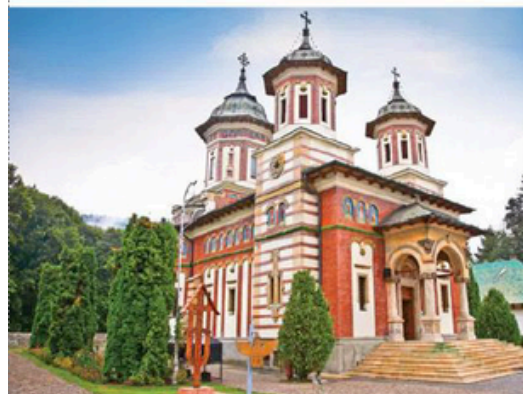
